Abridged Student Code of Conduct (see *Student Handbook for complete policy*)

- Student will always participate with a good attitude.
- Student will show respect to all staff and follow directions.

If a student violates the code of conduct, the student is given a verbal warning. After two verbal warnings a referral is written by the staff member. Consequences are given and written on the form and the referral must be signed by the parent or guardian. After three referrals the student is suspended. After six referrals the student is expelled from the Nest. Certain behaviors, such as physical violence (in anger or play), threats or harassment, result in a referral and a suspension for no less than two days and if continued after returning, the student is expelled from the program.

Release of Student Records

The UMC Youth Center is a 21st Century Community Learning Center (“21CLCC”) and obtains performance and outcome data from the Franklin County School District and Franklin County Learning Center. Data includes, but is not limited to, test scores, MAP scores, report card grades, attendance records and behavior code violations. By signing below, I authorize The UMC Youth Center to obtain such data to fulfill the reporting requirements of the 21st Century Community Learning Center grant as stipulated by the Florida Department of Education.

Selection Criteria

This UMC Youth Center program is open to all students in grades Pre-K through 8th grade, with priority provided to those students performing in the lowest 25th percentile on the FSA reading and/or math sections. The Nest is open to students regardless of race or economic status.

Abridged Attendance Policy (see *Handbook for complete policy*)

Students who are enrolled in The Nest must make best efforts to attend five days a week and stay for the full program day. Grant funding for The UMC Youth Center is based on the number of students attending and the site’s total hours of operation. Students who do not stay for the full time or attend on an irregular basis will not receive all the program’s services and will not be able to complete the required pre, mid and post tests required by the grant to chart students’ improvement.

Excused absences will include those that are excused based on the school district policy. Unexcused absences may result in removal from the program based on available openings. Slots CANNOT be held for students as drop in and those with repeated absences.
